

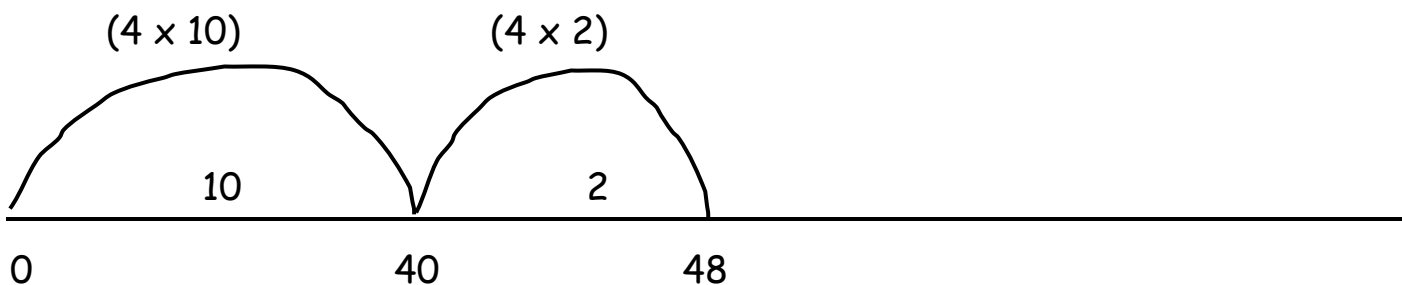
Division with Remainders on a Number Line

$$49 \div 4 =$$

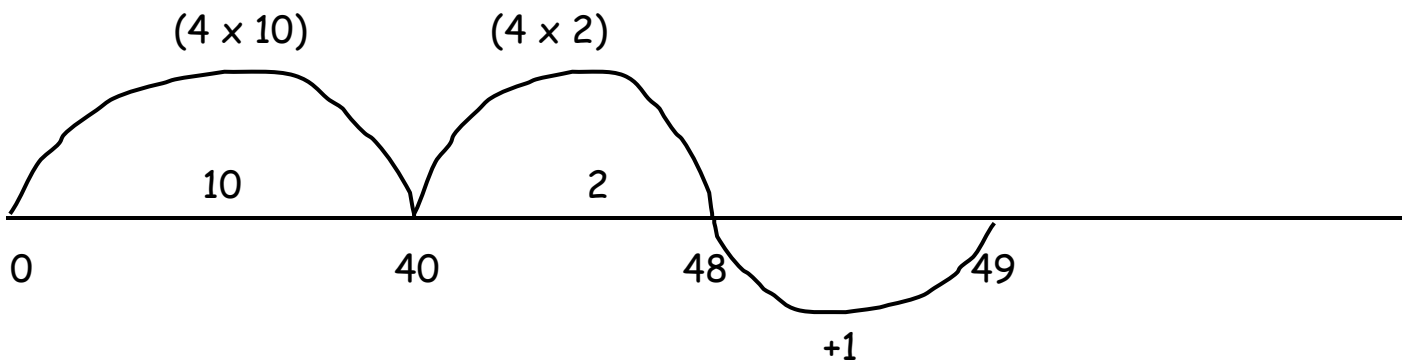
Draw a line.

Find 10 groups of your divisor, then find out how many groups of your divisor there are in the remaining amount.



When you can't make another group, record the remainder beneath the line.



Add the number of groups from both jumps together.

$$10 + 2 = 12$$

Record your answer in the number sentence and record the remainder as 'r'.

$$49 \div 4 = 12 \text{ r}1$$
